(They are playing Lost Boys in Neverland) Pants can be blue jeans, leggings, etc. Long sleeve shirt, short sleeve shirt or sweater within those colors work. Feel free to add a vest or any layer as long as it's within the color theme. | Jazz shoes/sneakers/ or brown or black boots as long as they can move/dance in them | I'm pretty open as long as it's out of their face. All back, half up/half down, braid, etc. Feel free to add a beanie, bandana, etc. as long as it's blue, green, tan or brown. | Monday | Dec. 2nd |

| | Mini Musical Theater | Audrey M. | Any dress in a bright color is good, but no logos! If any of the girls have Disney princess dresses, those are great! | Anything closed-toe; Mary Jane, tennis shoes, etc. No crocs please! | Away from face; half-up half-down is okay, but not all the way down please! | Wednesday | Dec. 4th |
| | Musical Theater 2 | Rachel S. | bright colored street clothes, can be solid colors or have patterns (no logos.) guys can wear any pants (jeans, etc.) that they can move in, girls can wear pants or skirts (skirts must have leggings underneath.) Any bright colored top will work. Feel free to add layers (flannels, vests, jackets, cardigans, suspenders, etc.) The costumes from this show are typically very eclectic. | Any shoes that they can move/dance in. Jazz shoes, sneakers, or boots. | Away from face; half-up half-down is okay, but not all the way down. They can add beanies, scarves, accessories, etc. Please make sure that anything added is secure with bobby pins and won't fall out. | Monday | Dec. 2nd |
| 5:30 PM | Musical Theater 1 | Coryn M. | RUBIANNA, ALEGRIA, MADELINE, MAGGIE: solid black clothing you can move in when dancing; feel free to match your hair, shoes, and clothing types (shirt and pants, jackets, vests, dresses, etc.) to your choice of Ancestor backstory (dancer, sailor, etc.)! ANDREA: long sleeve black dress, black tights; shoes - black; hair - straightened and down with the sides pinned back from face if needed RYLAN: dark button up, tie, black pants, and suit jacket or blazer; shoes - black dress shoes; hair - center or side part, gelled, combed to the sides of the part SABINE: all black (dress, shirt and skirt or pants, etc.), white collared top underneath, black tights; shoes - black; hair - two low braids SAM: black costume base (same as Ancestors), loose striped t shirt to throw on over base costume JASMINE: black long leggings, black tutu, black t shirt, cardigan and scarf to throw on over base costume NICOLE: light colored dress, at least knee-length; shoes - white or light colored; hair - half-up half-down and curled JASON: dark button up shirt (not black, patterned material is fine), tan pants CASH: light colored solid t shirt (no logos), tan pants, shoes: converse, hair: out of face | (Unless otherwise specified for your character) solid black or brown closed-toed shoes (jazz shoes, tennis shoes, boots, Doc Martens - match it to your character!) | out of your face - see character notes for specifics! | Monday | Dec. 2nd |

| | Jr. Musical Theater | Coryn M. | RYLAN, SADIE, MELODY: light blue dress; shoes - black shoes you can comfortably dance in (jazz, ballet flats, Mary Janes, preferably not sneakers); hair - low ponytail in the back MICHAEL: dark long sleeve button up shirt, dark dress pants, crown if you have one, cape or cloak if you have one (email me if not and I'll look for some!) ARLOWYN: townsperson costume base (see description below), cape or cloak to wear as the Old Woman (if you don't already own one, we can provide this - email me and let me know.) TOWNSPEOPLE (SOFIA, VIOLET, EMMET, SANTIAGO, KAILYN, MASON, ARLOWYN, CHARLOTTE): brown, white, gray, tan, green, yellow, and burgundy (no blue please) townsperson clothing that is comfortable to move in. Girls: dresses or blouses and skirts, accessories like aprons, ribbons, bonnets, etc. are welcome; Boys: button up long sleeves, trousers/dress pants (no jeans please), accessories like vests, jackets, aprons, belts are welcome | (Unless otherwise specified for your character) Solid black or brown closed-toed shoes that are comfortable to dance in (jazz shoes, dress shoes, boots) | (Unless otherwise specified for your character) GIRLS: pigtails, double braids, low bun BOYS: combed back to stay out of face | Monday | Dec. 2nd |

| | Musical Theater 2 | Coryn M. | LAUREN: light blue dress or gillyhicks, white tennis shoes EVAN: some sort of jacket (bomber jacket, blazer...), green pants, gray solid shirt, some sort of a top hat, patterned scarf; shoes - white sneakers LENNON: horizontal striped top (button up, sweater, t shirt...), black cargo pants, boots, leather jacket, cat ear headband ISABELLA: white button up, white or tan tank tops, tan cargo pants, white rabbit ear headband SABINE: dark blue/green/purple colors, gold-framed glasses QUETZALLI: all white (dress, shirt and pants...loose/flowy pieces you can dance in) | fitting to your character and able to dance in (must be closed-toed) | fitting to your character and out of your face | Monday | Dec. 2nd |
